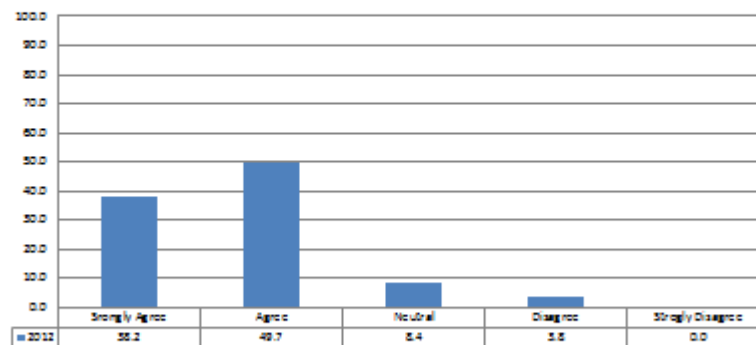


Feedback from Faculty 2012



Satisfaction Ratio: 74.2%

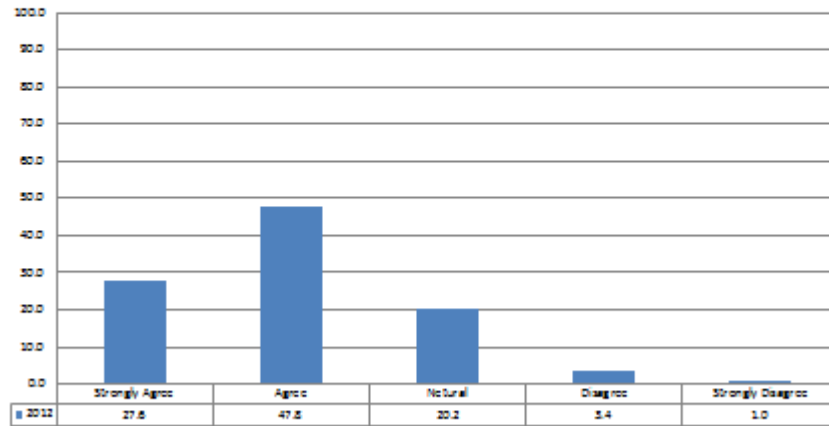
Feedback From Parents 2012



Satisfaction Ratio: 87.9%

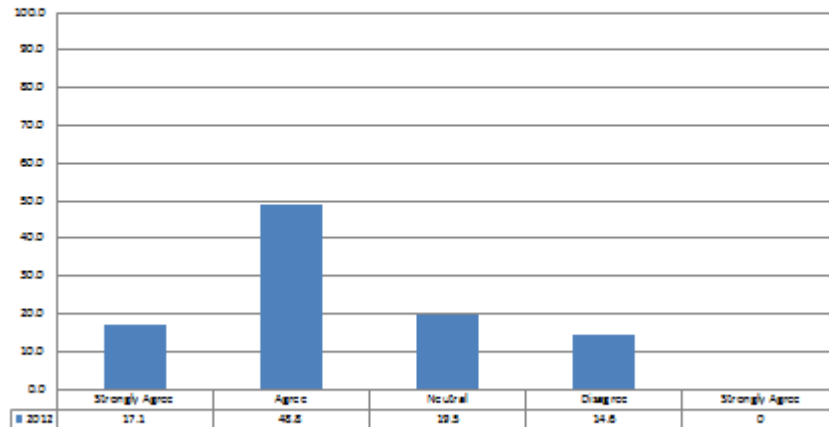


Feedback from Alumni 2012

2. The context that required the initiation of the practice

UGC funding is available for the Coaching for Entry in service exam, Coaching for UGC NET/SLET examination for minorities but no such funding is available for the open category students. Lack of ICT usage in such centers in university so benefits remain only for on campus students and for limited period. Lack of information and awareness among students for competitive examination and other career opportunity

3. Objectives of the practice To provide continuous support to student for post academic dynamic professional challenges

- To use available funding resources in sustainable mode
- To Use ICT and open source to create 24X7 support system for professional development to students

4. The Practice

We have approach to Shree Shree Deepchandbhai Gardi well known Philanthropist of country for creation of the Center for Professional development. He has given university Rs. 1 Corer. Instead of utilizing them in infrastructure development or limited time activity we have deposited that money and from yearly interest income decided to utilize for the annually in various activities. We have created an advisory committee and arranged two brain storming sessions analyzed the feedback from the student and gone through the SWOT analysis for created roadmap for further functioning. Center was initiated in the University central library so infrastructure expense and common newspaper magazine and book purchase was significantly reduced. We have created an online portal where regular information regarding the forthcoming competitive examination, resource material, online and offline quiz, quiz and question paper of old exam of UPSC, GPSC, UGC NET examination were kept. We have established network of subject experts from University, college and other institution for giving the best teaching.
